We have recently completed a number of public outreach efforts and have had time to evaluate the numerous comments, requests and concerns. Naturally, the proposed water treatment plant location and associated impacts to the surrounding neighbors and community garnered the most interest and comment. Based on the tremendous amount of public input and based on the environmental studies completed to date, District staff is re-focusing the environmental document to identify the Lodge Drive site as the preferred site. This will delay the public release of the environmental document until August. We will alert you to when it is available.
